The Josephine Mandriota Culinary Scholarship

The Josephine Mandriota Culinary Scholarship was created in the memory of Chef Anthony Mandriota's grandmother. This scholarship is a tribute to her legacy that inspired Chef Anthony to pursue his passion in the culinary arts and to celebrate our founding Chef's design of the program. The Josephine Mandriota Culinary Scholarship was created for students enrolling in Nossi College of Art's Associate of Occupational Studies in Culinary Arts program. Students must demonstrate an exceptional ability in culinary skill, creativity and a promising future as a professional culinarian. Additional requirements needed to earn this scholarship.

The amount of this scholarship is up to \$2,400 for the associate of occupational studies degree. It is disbursed to the recipient after the mid-term exam each semester, at the rate of \$400 each semester for a maximum of six (6) semesters for an associate degree, as satisfactory academic progress is made through the program.

THE JOSEPHINE MANDRIOTA CULINARY SCHOLARSHIP FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

This scholarship is for high school students enrolling in Nossi College of Art's Associate of Occupational Studies in Culinary Arts program directly after high school graduation. Students must demonstrate an exceptional ability in culinary skill, creativity and a promising future as a professional culinarian. This scholarship may be available for high school seniors within the United States or Internationally.

THE JOSEPHINE MANDRIOTA CULINARY SCHOLARSHIP FOR ADULTS OR TRANSFER STUDENTS

This scholarship is for adult and transfer students enrolling in Nossi College of Art's Associate of Occupational Studies in Culinary Arts program. Students must demonstrate an exceptional ability in culinary skill, creativity and a promising future as a professional culinarian. This scholarship may be available for adult and transfer students within the United States or Internationally.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Request the scholarship application prior to enrolling from your admissions representative.
2. Provide a detailed, one-page essay on why you wish to pursue a career in culinary arts.
3. Provide a letter of recommendation from the high school instructor, the guidance counselor, or other adult. Not a high school student? Include a letter of recommendation from a professional reference.
4. Include a copy of your official high school transcript.
- 5a. Submit a video of your signature dish from prep to plate. A written description of the process must accompany the video, including the recipe. The video must be edited to not exceed five (5) minutes in length. Submissions can be accepted via social media links (YouTube, Vimeo, Vine, Instagram, TikTok) or submitted via thumb drive, DVD, or CD. NCA is not responsible for damage or loss of submission.
OR
- 5b. Submit a series of photographs highlighting each stage of the process of your signature dish from prep to plate. A written description must accompany each photo/stage, including the recipe. Submissions can be accepted via thumb drive or printed album. NCA is not responsible for damage or loss of submission.
6. Submission of college application required for scholarship approval.



RECIPIENT'S NOTIFICATION AND ACCEPTANCE

All applicants will receive notification on the status of their scholarship. When the recipient accepts the scholarship, they agree to abide by the rules and regulations of the scholarship committee.

CONDITIONS FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

The college believes all scholarship recipients must maintain a high standard of academic excellence that earned them the reward of The Josephine Mandriota Culinary Scholarship. To encourage and foster excellence in education, the recipient must therefore make satisfactory academic progress throughout the length of the program.

Satisfactory academic progress for the purpose of the scholarship is defined as:

1. Maintaining a minimum "B" cumulative grade point average
2. Pass all subjects
3. Maintain a satisfactory attendance record as described in the attendance policy of the college catalog
4. Meet all financial obligations
5. Students must be enrolled in a minimum of two courses toward the degree of their major

To ensure the student has met academic satisfactory progress during the first semester, the scholarship will be awarded to selected students after the first mid-term examination results are completed. Subsequent disbursements are made after each mid-term exam of the remaining semesters. For an associate degree, there are six (6) semesters in the program. The amount of the scholarship is up to \$2,400 with the recipient receiving \$400 per semester. All funds will be applied to the student's tuition balance.

CONDITIONS FOR REVOKING THE SCHOLARSHIP

Disbursements of scholarship will be terminated any semester when it is determined:

1. The recipient has failed to maintain a "B" cumulative grade point average.
2. The recipient has failed a course.
3. The recipient has not met their financial obligations.
4. The recipient has not met the college's satisfactory attendance policy.
